Description of Risk	Mitigation	Comments
Site Area clearly Identified.	Clearly mark total area required with disinfected markers creating a zoned area for training.	Especially needed when training in public park.
Social Distancing in groups	Clearly mark areas for groups within the session to comply with social distancing	Constantly remind all participants to adopt a social distance and wear masks if spectating whenever possible. If breached then immediately hand sanities at the station.
Sanitising	Identify area for all sanitising equipment available	Sanitising Station to have Hand Sanitiser/Disinfectant for equipment/Hand wipes/ Notice board & First Aid Bag.
Player Heath Check	Ask all players to complete health questionnaire All track and trace sheets to be sent to trackandtraceetyfc@gmail.com after every training session or match	Temp Check 37.8 and above id considered too high temperature and player must be sent home All teams will have temperature guns available
Goal Celebrations/Handling of Ball/ Hand Sanitising/Spitting/ Disinfecting.	Brief all participants including staff on current safety guidelines at the beginning of every training session.	Make sure all are aware of this guidelines. If guidelines are not adhered to then participants will be asked to leave the training session.
Transmission through Equipment.	Disinfect all equipment before and during and after. Any bibs used will stay with the individual player throughout the session.	
Action if any incidents	Record kept of all attendees. Report to Club Chairman/Secretary of any incidents	



<p>Suspected Covid 19 with a participant</p>	<p>If a player becomes unwell at training. Ensure social distancing measures are in place. Ask participant to leave. Any participant to come into contact with the suspected case or any participant who has been exposed to this person through transmission risks will need to leave and follow the 2 week isolation guidelines.</p>	<p>Training will stop immediately and players will be asked to leave. The club will then make further actions to ensure the safety of the participants remains in regards to training in the future. Letters have gone out to all parents regarding self-isolation if a member of the team tests positive.</p>
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
